

2022 INDOOR STATE CHAMPIONSHIP MEET

ELIGIBILITY

The OAT&CCC Indoor State Meet is open only to athletes whose coaches are members of the Ohio Association of Track & Cross Country Coaches. Join Online

To be eligible to compete in the OAT&CCC Indoor State Meet, all of the following requirements MUST be met by schools, athletes, and coaches. **Failure to meet any of the above requirements will result in the athlete not being permitted to participate.**

- 1. Each competitor must:
 - a. Be a member of the school team where the athlete is enrolled as a student;
 - b. Wear a school-issued uniform. OHSAA uniform rules will be in effect;
 - c. Meet all OHSAA eligibility requirements; and
 - d. Have a school coach present at the meet.
- 2. Each school's team must be approved and recognized by the local Board of Education and the school must be a 2021-2022 member in good-standing with the OHSAA.
- Each coach must be approved and recognized by the local Board of Education and be a paid member of the OAT&CCC. (Must complete the online OATCCC <u>Verification Form</u> due the Wednesday before the State meet - March 2nd)

PERFORMANCE LISTS



The OAT&CCC Performance Lists in each division (D2/3 & D1) will reflect the TOP 40 athletes or relay teams in each event. The lists will be posted on **MileSplit Ohio** (www.oh.milesplit.com)

Only marks meeting the following requirements will be included on the performance lists:

- 1. Marks must be obtained while athletes are competing as members of their school team. The school team must be listed as the athlete/relay team's affiliation on the official meet results at the time the mark was achieved. (No retroactive affiliation allowed)
- 2. Marks from athletes or relay teams listed as unattached or with a club affiliation in the official meet results will NOT be accepted.
- 3. Marks will NOT be accepted from meets that do not appear on the list of accepted OAT&CCC qualifying meets.
- 4. Final day of accepted performances is Sunday, February 20th at 10:00pm.

QUALIFYING

To be eligible for participation in the Indoor State Meet:

- An athlete or relay team must be listed on the FINAL TOP 40
 PERFORMANCE LIST posted on MileSplit Ohio for each event in which they intend to compete.
- 2. The top 24 athletes or relay teams in each event that declare their intent to compete will be accepted for the meet.
- 3. Each school is limited to 2 entries in any individual event and 1 relay team per relay event.

DECLARATION & REGISTRATION



- 1. The **FINAL TOP 40 PERFORMANCE LIST** will be released by Wednesday, February 23rd at 12:00noon.
- 2. To enter the OAT&CCC Indoor State Meet, the official coach of the high school team must register all athletes from the list that wish to participate.
- 3. The registration window will remain open from Wednesday, February 23rd at 12:00noon until Friday, February 25th at 11:59pm.
- 4. The list of accepted entries will be posted by Sunday, February 27th.

MEET DAY INFO

- ☑ 2022 NFHS and OHSAA competition rules will be in effect.
- All competitors must compete in school-issued uniform with all all uniform rules in effect.
- ☑ All COVID precautions will be in place for everyone's safety.
- ☑ Alternate relay athletes must pay for entry as a spectator.
- Spectators will be allowed in the facility unless otherwise announced.
- ☑ Live streaming of the event will be available on MileSplit Ohio
- Results will be available at Lightning Timing (<u>www.lightningtiming.com</u>)
- Athletic training staff and a physician will be provided by The Cleveland Clinic.
- ☑ Official Indoor State Meet shirts will be available for purchase on-site only.
